

Stock Study Presentation – Brent presented NMI Holdings, Inc. (NMIH), providing a thorough analysis of the stock, an overview of the company and how it is positioned for the future.

Review of Stock Portfolio: Members presented their updates for stocks they were watching. Sriram showed the dashboard for the Yankee portfolio from Manifest Investing and the PERT chart for the Yankee portfolio, which has lots of red on it indicating missing sales and earnings milestones.

Watchlist: Small – IRMD (HOLD) Medium – AX (HOLD), FTNT (HOLD), GNTX (BUY), PAYC (HOLD), PAYX (HOLD) Large – NVDA (HOLD)

Buy/Sell decisions -

SELL: None

BUY: NMIH with all available cash.



General club business:

Old:

- Check the capital gains and losses: As indicated in the treasurer's report, the club has about a \$17,246 short term loss and about a \$17,605 long-term gain so far this year.
- The WASH BUY was successful, I think.
- Sriram to send Jack signed check for \$52.00 made out to Sriram.
- Remove Ira from the Fidelity Account and from authorized individuals.
- Steve to pay his bill.

New:

- New slate of officers was proposed by Sriram and unanimously elected by the members:

 - Vice President Steve Roy
 - Secretary Jessica Glant
 - Treasurer Sriram Madabushi
 - Asst. Treasurer Brent Goll
- Sriram shall initiate sending the new Fidelity application including the partnership agreement to all members again. Unless someone can arrange electronic signatures for us, sending documents to everyone for signatures takes more than a month. The new slate of officers will be listed on the Fidelity documents.
- We now have four prospective members: Mo Hart, John Hangen, Randall Webb and Matthew Sweeney. We need to schedule dates for them to present a stock to study.
- In answer to questions about the \$200/month investment, the partnership agreement states that the amount can be reduced with a vote by the membership. We agreed that a \$50 monthly investment would be acceptable.

Questions from visitors – (Answers are mostly from Joe Farrell).

- Since the investment holding is all capitalization stock (large, mid, small, etc.) it will be interesting to compare club performance with total market fund instead of the S&P500 index.
 - The club has always used the default. I will discuss the 45 or so alternatives available on the software for comparison. My choice would be VTSMX, a Vanguard Total Stock Market Fund. I will see if I can get a change. I believe the SP500 fund is used because most people know what the SP500 is.
- Yes. Kudos to this investment club! Your presentations are awesome. Unfortunately, I am unable to join because I reside in Indiana. Continue with the good work.
- When joining is there a maximum amount that I can join with?
 - Yes. At present it is this formula: 2 * 1/n, where n is the number of members. With n=5 members, the limit is 40%. With n=9, it is 22.22%.
